B. All strike aircraft carry flak suppression munitions to counter enemy firings except those carrying special munitions, i.e., MK-36s.

C. Low level recon will only be performed as authorized by this headquarters and then only by the best crews as certified by the Wing Commander.

D. Gunships are escorted by fighters for flak suppression. F-4s with each AC-130 and A-1s will escort the AC-130s when they are committed to Laos.

E. Gunship routes are planned with reference to the degree of moonlight. On high moonlight nights, they are employed on lower threat routes.

F. Flight routes, attack areas, and timing are being reviewed to avoid stereotyped operations that are predictable by the enemy.

G. Special operations are conducted against AAA concentrations when and where required. Examples were the attack of 11 Nov by 31 sorties against guns firing across the border at Mu Gia Pass and the attack of 26 November by 36 aircraft against the gun
